MINUTES

Present: Chairman Shane Stuart, Vice Chairman Joe Branham, Councilman Brad Jordan, Councilman Mike Vaughn, Councilman Alex Oliphant, Councilman Pete Wilson, Clerk to Council Karen Lee and County Attorney Joanie Winters. Councilwoman Mary Guy arrived at 5:47 pm.

1. **Call to Order**-Meeting was called to order at 5:45 pm by Chairman Stuart
2. **Approval of October 15th, 2018 CCTC Minutes.** - Councilman Wilson motioned to approve, second by Councilman Vaughn. Vote 5-0 to approve.
3. **New Business**
 - a. **Library Parking Lot-LB Cannon**

Mr. Cannon stated they were looking to do two parking lots behind the library and trying to decide without being qualified as a major improvement, if it's considered a major improvement then all ADA would be required. The curbing is not a DOT right of way, he had contacted Julie Powers to see if C-Funds could be used. But may not qualify, on the Richburg and Bethlehem sites the driveways were done and did not go off dot's right of way.

Councilman Oliphant stated the curbing needed to be replaced, the parking lot could get by being patched and coated. He and Vice Chairman Branham both stated a spreadsheet is needed to show what needs to be done in the County that could be put in a one cents sale tax. Vice Chairman Branham asked what Mr. Cannon recommended for the library that could last maybe three or four years until it could possibly be added to the one cents sales tax. Mr. Cannon stated he would do it in two phases, parking lot first then do the curbing second.
 - b. **Request to Reimburse the County Roads Department for Road Maintenance from August 2018 to January 8th, 2019 in the Amount of \$10,285.97 dollars.**

Councilman Oliphant motioned to approve, second by Vice Chairman Branham. Vote 6-0 to approve.
 - c. **Request to Reimburse the County Recycling Department for Sign Material from August 2018 to September 2018 in the Amount of \$1172.67 dollars.** Vice Chairman Branham motioned to approve, second by Councilwoman Guy. Vote 6-0 to approve.
4. **Adjourn**-Councilman Wilson motioned to adjourn, second by Councilman Oliphant. Vote 6-0 to adjourn.
