a. Update Phase II Non- Reoccurring Lynches River contractor

LB Cannon stated Cameron and Gethsemane Church Road were done with the exception of adding the thermal plastic and striping, should be completed this week. Three hundred feet of guard rail was installed on Howe Road by SCDOT.

b. Update RIP 2017 County Roads Lineberger contractor

Mr. Cannon stated sixty seven percent have been completed, they are around a week behind. Reclamation will be added to Doctors Court, which will be held on Saturdays so as not to disrupt the doctor and dentist office. Rebel Creek, Connor Road, Mayhugh Road and Hindman Road in Fort Lawn.
