1. Approval of CCTC Meeting Minutes of November 5, 2012  
**CCTC Member Lucas made a Motion to approve the CCTC Meeting Minutes of November 5, 2012, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.**
2. Reimbursement of Road Sign Material in the amount of \$1,169.36  
**CCTC Member Lucas made the Motion to reimburse the Recycle/Litter Control Department \$1,169.36 from C-Funds, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Oliphant, CCTC vote was unanimous.**
3. Update on Raxter Rd. and Hunting Oaks contract  
**Mr. LB Cannon** gave the CCTC members an update on the Raxter Road and Hunting Oaks contracts stating that this project was 100% complete. **Mr. Cannon** stated that

the Raxter Rd. project would be completed in two to three weeks depending on the weather. CCTC Member Lucas asked would the new road take care of really high water and **Mr. Cannon** replied "definitely." CCTC Vice Chairman Branham asked how residents had been getting back and forth and Mr. Cannon replied that a secondary road had been built to handle this.

4. Update on road behind Walmart

**Mr. LB Cannon** stated that there was approximately 850 feet of road the County had agreed to take into the road system once it was in spec. **CCTC Vice Chairman Branham** asked if the city had also put funds in this project and **CCTC Member Oliphant** stated they had. **Mr. Cannon** stated the road was now up to County specification. **CCTC Member Guy then made a Motion to take that portion of the road behind Walmart into the County Road System, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Oliphant, CCTC vote was unanimous.**
