II. Old Business

1. Approval of CCTC Meeting Minutes of May 21, 2012

2. Request for reimbursement for coal mix in amt. of \$1,888.92 to Road Dept..

The Dennis Corporation received the most points and CCTC **Chairman Roddey made the Motion that the Dennis Corporation be chosen as the Chester County Engineering Firm, 2nd by CCTC Member Oliphant, CCTC vote was unanimous.**
