32 **I. Call to Order**

33 **II. Old Business**

34 1. Approval of CCTC Minutes of June 2, 2008

35 **Vice Chairman Lucas made a Motion to approve the CCTC Minutes of June 2, 2008,**
36 **2nd by Councilwoman Guy, CCTC Committee vote was unanimous.**

37 2. Update on 2006, 2008 DOT Report

38 **LB Cannon** stated that the 2006 and 2008 DOT expenditures were below the 25% that
39 were needed and have now exceeded that amount with the sidewalk project just
40 completed.

41 3. Update on Sidewalk Project

42 **LB Cannon** said the project would be completed tomorrow with some asphalt and

1 cleanup.

2 4. Update on 2008 Road Project

3 **LB Cannon** stated they were 18% through. Langley Rd. was completed and Crystal
4 Creek and McCree were next. Mr. Cannon stated that the CTC expenditures were
5 estimated at \$200,000-275,000 and came in at \$310,642.28 on State Roads. Mr.
6 Cannon stated they would need at least \$35,000 to complete the entire package of DOT
7 roads. The increase was due to the liquid petroleum in the asphalt. **Councilwoman Guy**
8 **made the Motion to transfer \$40,000 from C-Funds to finish the DOT projects, 2nd**
9 **by Councilman Jordan.** Discussion: **Councilman Jordan** asked Mr. Cannon if he had
10 checked on Hwy. 9 and 901. Mr. Cannon asked Mr. Stan Bland with SCDOT to
11 look at this and Mr. Bland gave him a figure of \$88,000. **Vice Chairman Lucas**
12 stated he did not see any roads on the list Mr. Cannon gave Council from District 2.
13 Mr. Cannon said this was DOT information and they went by numbers and that
14 Old Winnsboro Road was in District 2 and it was Tanglewood and the cost was
15 \$98,643.48 and these were the roads Council approved. **Chairman Roddey** then
16 explained to **Vice Chairman Lucas** that District 2 was getting one third of the entire
17 amount allotted. **Council then voted and the vote was unanimous.**

19 III. **New Business**

20 1. Application of Solv-Polymer on roads off Armory

21 **LB Cannon** stated that due to the increase of the SCDOT project he would
22 recommend that Council put off the applying of the polymer on the roads off
23 Armory Rd. until we know the balance of the C-Fund account. **Vice Chairman**
24 **Lucas** asked what percent increase was he talking about on DOT roads and
25 Mr. Cannon said about 15% and the majority of increase was in liquid asphalt
26 and **Vice Chairman Lucas** asked if we did have a contract that would say the
27 price couldn't go up once it was signed and Mr. Cannon said only a fuel
28 adjustment was included in contracts and that's all.

29 2. Discussion on driveway paving estimates

30 **LB Cannon** stated that he had several requests to pave driveway aprons mostly
31 in subdivisions and would like permission to get estimates. **Councilman Oliphant**
32 **made the Motion to allow the Dennis Corporation to get estimates on the driveway**
33 **aprons, 2nd by Councilwoman Guy.** Discussion: **Councilman Jordan** asked which
34 driveways and Mr. Cannon replied Golden Maple and others and **Chairman**
35 **Roddey** also said probably anywhere we're paving. **Council then voted and the**
36 **vote was unanimous.**
