II. Public Hearing

III. Setting of Millage Rates for FY 2010-2011

Mr. Baker told Council Members that the millage actually went down from 199.9 mills to 199.1 mills. **Council Member Oliphant** asked if this included The fire districts and everything else and Mr. Baker stated it did. **Council Member Jordan** asked why Lando and Richburg increased slightly and Mr. Baker said they had asked for an increase in operations and it was approved. **Council Member Oliphant** then said the Debt

Service went down significantly and Mr. Baker replied yes it did. **Council Member Guy** asked if there was any tax increase and Mr. Baker replied no. **Chairman Roddey** asked if there were any more questions for Mr. Baker and there were none. At this time, **Council Member Oliphant made a Motion to adopt the Millage Rate as recommended for Fiscal year 2010-2011, 2nd by Council Member Branham, Council vote was unanimous.**
