The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by Sylvia Jennings, Chairman. Chairman Jennings welcomed the Steering Committee members and Bhavin Patel, Secretary asked if anyone had any revisions or edits to the minutes from the August 1, 2018 meeting. Walt Whitman made a motion to approve the minutes and Ed Sharpe seconded the motion. Following discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

Following a period of discussion, the Steering Committee decided to meet as one group and not break out into the subcommittees. The first item on the agenda was the Committee Updates. Hall Crenshaw, Beautification Committee Chair introduced Mitchell Starnes, Shamrock Landscaping who presented a proposed project for landscaping lighting improvements for at Exit 65. A motion was made by Ed Sharpe

to approve the lighting project and the motion was seconded by Bhavin Patel. Following discussion, the motion passed unanimously. Tony Pope stated the Chester Development Foundation would sponsor half of the project cost and Hal Crenshaw committed to sponsor \$5,000 of the total project cost. Ed Sharpe made a motion for the Steering Committee to raise funds for the landscaping lighting improvements project with donations made payable to the Chester Development Foundation. Walt Whitman seconded the motion. Following discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

Next, the Steering Committee discussed the initiatives of the Infrastructure/Growth Committee. Tony Pope provided information on recent water and sewer enhancement projects.

A motion was made by Mr. Crenshaw to add new and old business to the Steering Committee's routine agenda. The motion was seconded by Ed Sharpe and unanimously approved.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 11:30 AM.
