37 1. Approval of CCTC Minutes of November 3, 2008

38 **Vice Chairman Lucas made a Motion to approve the CCTC Minutes of**
39 **November 3, 2008, 2nd by Councilman Branham, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

40 **III. New Business**

41 **LB Cannon** came before Council to discuss the following roads:

42 a) Carobrooks Road off Edwards Drive in Ft. Lawn

1 **Mr. Cannon** said the road was in good shape but would need some shoulder repair and that
2 the owner was not in good health and wanted to also give the county two lots for green
3 space. **Vice Chairman Lucas** asked if the County had the proper equipment to maintain
4 the roads already in the county system and **Chairman Roddey** said they had a machine to
5 patch the roads. **Councilman Oliphant** said he would like more information on the “green
6 space” and **Mr. Cannon** said he would get more information and bring it back to the next
7 meeting. **Councilman Oliphant then made a Motion to table this item until Mr. Cannon**
8 **could get more information, 2nd by Councilman Branham, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

9 b) Fishing Creek dirt road (at Walton property)

10 **Mr. Cannon** said the Walton’s had asked that the County deed this road to them because
11 of people coming in and out and that the road had been closed for 18-20 years and that
12 the bridge was out on the property. **Mr. Cannon** said there were also other owners around
13 and if the road were deeded to the Walton’s they may not be able to get to their property.
14 **Councilman Oliphant** asked if a letter could be sent to the other property owners to see
15 if they would have a problem with closing the road totally. **Chairman Roddey** then asked how
16 it could be explained that we were giving one of the property owners the road. **Councilman**
17 **Branham** asked the County Attorney her thoughts on this. **County Attorney Winters** said that
18 legally we could have problems, there were a lot of issues and she and LB had tried to come up
19 with a solution but didn’t have one at this time. **Vice Chairman Lucas** asked if the other
20 property owners could sign something saying they didn’t care if the road was deeded to the
21 Walton’s as long as they had access to their property. **County Attorney Winters** said she
22 could draw up paperwork and have a reverter clause in there. **Vice Chairman Lucas then**
23 **made a Motion to give this agenda item back to Mr. Cannon and the County Attorney to**
24 **get in touch with all of the owners of the properties off old Fishing Creek dirt road and**
25 **have an answer at the January meeting, 2nd by Councilman Oliphant, CCTC vote was**
26 **unanimous.**

27 c) Eugina Drive (off Murdock near I-77)

28 **Mr. Cannon** said there was one property owner on that road that would not sign the petition
29 and it did not look like he would change his mind. **Mr. Cannon** said he didn’t live there he lived
30 in Charlotte and he actually wanted to sell the property. **Vice Chairman Lucas** said the best
31 way to handle this was not to let one person hold this project up. **Councilman Oliphant** asked
32 if it could be taken in as maintenance only and **Mr. Cannon** said we could. **Councilman**
33 **Oliphant then made a Motion to take Eugina in the system for maintenance purposes**
34 **only, 2nd by Councilman Branham, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

35 d) Haylie Lane (Edgemoor section with 66 ft. right of way in place)

36 **Mr. Cannon** said there were five owners on this road that all wanted the road taken into the
37 County Road System. **Councilman Oliphant** asked about the condition of the road and **Mr.**

1 Cannon said there was just one small pot hole in the road. Councilman Jordan then made
2 a Motion to take Haylie Lane into the County Road System, 2nd by Councilman Branham,
3 CCTC vote was unanimous.

6 Vice Chairman Lucas made a Motion to adjourn, 2nd Councilwoman Guy, CCTC
7 vote was unanimous. Time was approximately 6:00 pm
